SPECIAL MEETING
February 6, 2023

The Keiser City Council met in special session Monday February 6, 2023 at 6 pm at Keiser City Hall. In attendance were Mayor Rick Creecy; Recorder/Treasurer Peggy Sellars; and Councilmembers Donna Bell, Laura Smith, and Lynn Skaggs.

The meeting was called to allow candidates for the vacant council seat to present to the council their vision for the City of Keiser.

Candidates in attendance were Donnie Ammons, Joey Jackson, and Mike Smith.

All candidates expressed their desire to see improvements in the city's drainage.

Ammons stated that he believed Keiser to be well situated to reap the rewards of a growing economy in Mississippi County.

Jackson encouraged the council to vote for the right person. He further stated "if I am not the right person, then don't vote for me."

Smith envisions Keiser as a clean, family-oriented, safe place where citizens take pride in their surroundings. He further stated that the citizens want to feel like someone is listening to them.

Mayor Creecy asked the council to consider each candidates qualifications and vision for the city and be prepared to make an appointment at the regular meeting on February 20, 2023.
