

ORDINANCE NO. 2000-3

AN ORDINANCE THAT NO GAS, AIR, OR SPRING OPERATED GUN, BE DISCHARGED WITHIN THE ENVIRONS OF THE CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF KEISER, ARKANSAS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KEISER, ARKANSAS:

Section 1. That due to the injury which affect the citizenry and because of the safety, health, and welfare of the citizens of this city, the operation of any gas, air or spring type rifle, "BB", pellet gun or pistol that if such is used and discharged in the public limits of this City, shall be declared illegal and punishable as a misdemeanor.

Section 2. No person shall carry, use or discharge any or all types of such pellet, "BB", air rifle or pistol or any other such weapon which is gas, air or spring operated within the confines of the City: further, that if any minor child or children discharge such weapons so described herein, their parent, parents or those having actual custody and care of such respective minors shall therefore be held liable for such acts of said child or children and shall be subjected to the penalty provision of this ordinance cited in Section 3 herein.

Section 3. Any person, persons, parent and/or legal guardian, and/or person having control and custody of a minor child or children, in violation of the provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof be fined not less than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) no more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) for each and every offense.

Section 4. All prior ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 5. This Ordinance being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, comfort, convenience, morals, safety, and welfare of the City of Keiser, Arkansas, an emergency is declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from the date of its adoption.

ORDINANCE NO. 2000-4

AN ORDINANCE THAT NO CROSSBOW OR BOW AND ARROW, OR ANY OTHER BOW AND ARROW CONFIGURATION BE DISCHARGED WITHIN THE ENVIRONS OF THE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF KEISER, ARKANSAS; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KEISER, ARKANSAS:

Section 1. That due to the injury which affect the citizenry and because of the safety, health, and welfare of the citizens of this city, the operation of any crossbow, bow and arrow or any other bow and arrow configuration that if such is used and discharged in the public limits of this City, shall be declared illegal and punishable as a misdemeanor.

Section 2. That if any minor child or children discharge such weapons so described herein, their parent, parents or those having actual custody and care of such respective minors shall therefore be held liable for such acts of said child or children and shall be subjected to the penalty provision of this ordinance cited in Section 3 herein.


Section 3. Any person, persons, parent and/or legal guardian, and/or person having control and custody of a minor child or children, in violation of the provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof be fined not less than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) no more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) for each and every offense.


Section 4. All prior ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 5. This Ordinance being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, comfort, convenience, morals, safety, and welfare of the City of Keiser, Arkansas, an emergency is declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from the date of its adoption.
